Position Description: The Clinical Faculty position at Project Vida Health Center plays a vital role in providing clinical instruction, supervision, and mentorship to psychiatry residents and other members of the mental health treatment team. This faculty position involves combining teaching responsibilities with active involvement in direct patient care and clinical practice.

Project Vida Health Center, a non-profit Federally Qualified Health Center located in El Paso, Texas, serves approximately 13,000 unduplicated individuals through various clinical, educational, and outreach services supported by federal, state, and local funding sources. Established in 2004, the organization is dedicated to addressing the needs of underserved areas of El Paso and includes a newly accredited community-based Psychiatry Residency Program.

The selected candidate will have a strong clinical background with experience in the diagnosis and treatment of a variety of mental disorders. They will also have board certification in Psychiatry. Compensation for this position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. This is a full-time position, with an immediate start date following licensure in Texas and completion of credentialing. Applications will be evaluated as received, and the start date is negotiable. The position will remain open until filled.

Clinical Faculty members are given extensive independent judgment in supervising residents, medical students, and social workers who make up our treatment team. They review medical information and provide expert opinions regarding the diagnosis and treatment of mental health patients. The psychiatrist will oversee treatment plans and patient progress, serve as a consultant on specific cases, and examine and treat patients whose condition may also require pharmacological intervention.





In addition to the clinical responsibilities, the Clinical Faculty will actively participate in the education and training of psychiatry residents in the newly accredited Psychiatry Residency Program. This includes participating in didactic sessions, facilitating case discussions, and providing guidance and support to residents in their academic pursuits. The Clinical Faculty will play a pivotal role in shaping the next generation of psychiatrists through their teaching and mentorship.
