TEXAS VACCINES FOR CHILDREN

The Texas Vaccines for Children (TVFC) program provides free or low-cost vaccines to eligible children in Texas, ensuring they have access to recommended vaccinations regardless of their ability to pay.

Who is Eligible for TVFC?

- Children from birth through 18 years of age who are:
- Uninsured
- Underinsured (Insurance doesn't cover vaccines.)
- Enrolled in Medicaid or CHIP
- Native American or Native Alaskan
