

Notice of Filing of a Labor Condition Application with the Employment and Training Administration

In compliance with Department of Labor requirements for employers petitioning for H-1B visas, Project Vida Health Center posts this notice of the position for which it intends to hire an H-1B employee.

1. H-1B nonimmigrant worker is being sought by Project Vida Health Center through the filing of a labor condition application with the Employment and Training Administration of the U.S. Department of Labor
2. One such worker is being sought.
