**Appointment Criteria Policy**

Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to outline the criteria and guidelines for appointing residents to the Graduate Medical Education (GME) program at Project Vida Health Center.

Policy: The following is the criteria to appoint trainees/residents at Project Vida Health Center Graduate Medical Education Residency Program(s).

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Licensing: Residents should be eligible for licensure in the State of Texas.

2. United States Medical Licensing Examination (USMLE): Applicants must have passed all USMLE Step 1 and Step 2 examinations, or equivalent licensure examinations for COMLEX in the number of attempts as indicated by the Texas Medical Board for licensure.

3. Criminal History Verification: Prospective residents are required to undergo a criminal history check as per the guidelines outlined in Project Vida Health Care's GME Criminal Background Policy.
